Historical Note

Born in Medford, Massachusetts, Joseph J. Mercurio served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II where he met his wife, Marion Mercurio. The two settled in Sarasota, where Joseph Mercurio opened an accounting practice and became actively involved in a number of local organizations including the Sarasota Chamber of Commerce, Kiwanis Club, Field Club, Miss Florida Pageant Association, and Riverview Kiltie Cultural Foundation, among many others. He and his wife traveled extensively in their retirement years prior to her passing in 2008 and his passing in 2012.
